## **Transplant Insurance Billing**

#### Insurance Plans

Fairview Specialty Pharmacy accepts most insurance plans, Medicare Part B and D and state medical assistance. We will apply to become a provider if we do not yet accept your plan. If you have a second or third insurance policy, we may be able to bill them.

#### Medicare and Secondary Insurance

If you have Medicare, we will bill them for you. Medicare Part B will cover 80% of your immunosuppressants. These might include:

- Gengraf/Neoral (cyclosporine)
- Prograf/Astagraf XL/Envarsus XR (tacrolimus)
- Deltasone (prednisone)
- Myfortic (mycophenolic acid)
- CellCept (mycophenolate)
- Rapamune (sirolimus)
- Imuran (azathioprine)
- Zortress (everolimus)

After billing Medicare Part B, we will charge the rest of the costs to a second insurance plan, if allowed. Some plans will only take claims directly from you (the beneficiary).

If your plan will accept claims from us:

- We will let you know at 90 and 120 days if the insurer is not paying your claims.
- After 120 days, if the insurer does not respond, you will need to make the 20% co-payment. We will tell you how to submit these claims. If you have a change in your insurance coverage, you must tell us right away.
